Wellsprings is a new eight-week course of refreshment and pampering, looking at issues women face today from a Christian perspective. It offers a 'pre-Alpha' evangelism course suitable for single and married women - those who have contact with Christians through friendship, or church activities such as parent and child groups or keep fit classes. Developed by Leesa Barton the course aims to strengthen the relationships that have been formed with these women; to explore practical ways to treat and look after themselves; to address key issues that affect women today; and to share relevant Christian truths.

The course first ran as part of 'Oasis' at Buckhurst Hill Baptist Church - thanks to all the ladies there for being part of the vision.

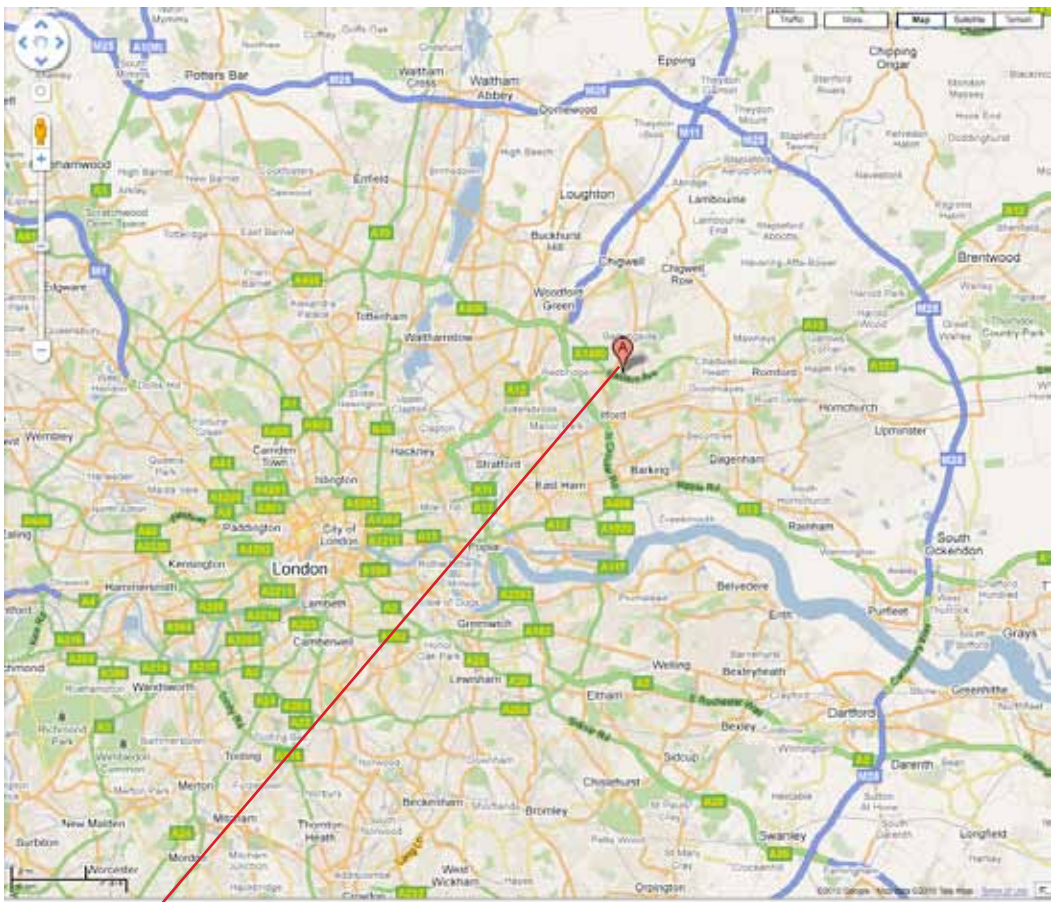
Speaker: Leesa Barton

Leesa is an Essex girl, born in Rochford near Southend and she grew up in Hawkwell Baptist Church, Rochford. Her working life began in a bank and then with an insurance broker. Leesa worked for Youth for Christ for eight years, where she was the Director for Epping Forest Youth for Christ for six years.

Leesa became assistant minister at Buckhurst Hill Baptist Church in 2004 and trained at Spurgeon's College as an evangelist.

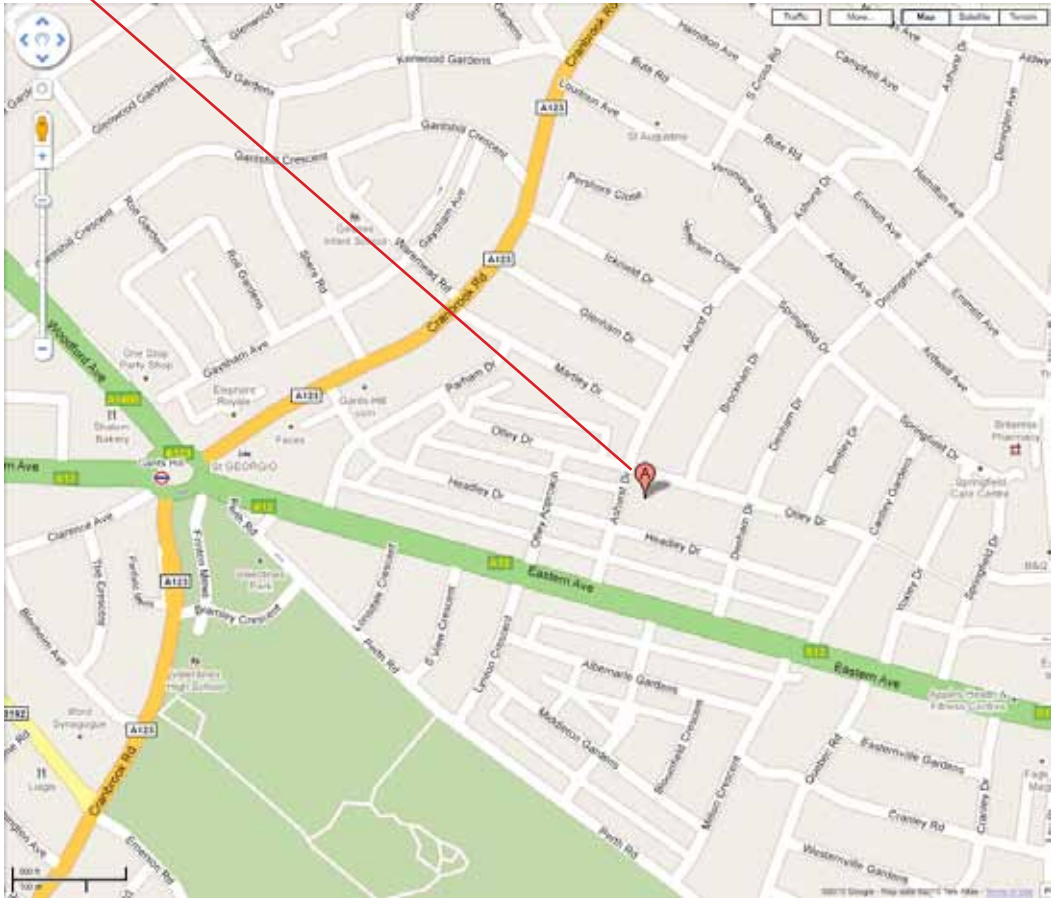
Leesa first ran a course similar to Wellsprings in 2005 with a daytime ladies' group and has run subsequent courses with ladies connected to the Parent and Toddler group at her church and from Keep Fit classes. Several of the ladies have gone on to join Alpha courses and some are now part of a home group and go to church. Some bring husbands and children along as well.
